

## 5 COOPERS COTTAGE Main Western Road



This delightful garden is divided into several "rooms", arranged with a variety of trees and shrubs. Magnificent bougainvillea standards, wisteria, roses, bulbs, vireyas and clivias. Cottage plantings include foxgloves, hollyhocks, wallflowers, poppies, dianthus and daisies. Standing above them magnolias, Japanese maples and Gingko bilobas.

Allow 45 minutes

## 6 TALLARINGA Long Road



Enter this large, sweeping garden through a rainforest and emerge to panoramic views of the coast, wide lawns (perfect for a picnic) and massed plantings. Wander along winding pathways to admire rhododendrons, magnolias, michelias, camellias, Japanese maples, azaleas, clivias, a wide variety of bulbs and more.

Allow 60+ minutes

## 7 CARINYA Carey Parade



A track through lush rainforest leads to this developing oasis, carefully sculpted by terracing around its centrepiece dam surrounded by cannas, agapanthus, bromeliads and cordylines. Sweeping lawns offer a parkland atmosphere and breathtaking views to the Gold Coast and a 4km round-trip walk through native forest.

Allow 90+ minutes

## 9 CAIMBEUL Main Western Road



Formerly a treeless dairy paddock, this garden developed through a quasi-scientific interest in plantings. Trees brought to the property became the defining structures of the various garden rooms. A diverse selection of shrubs, herbaceous plants and bulbs has been added over many years to provide decoration and interest.

Allow 45 minutes

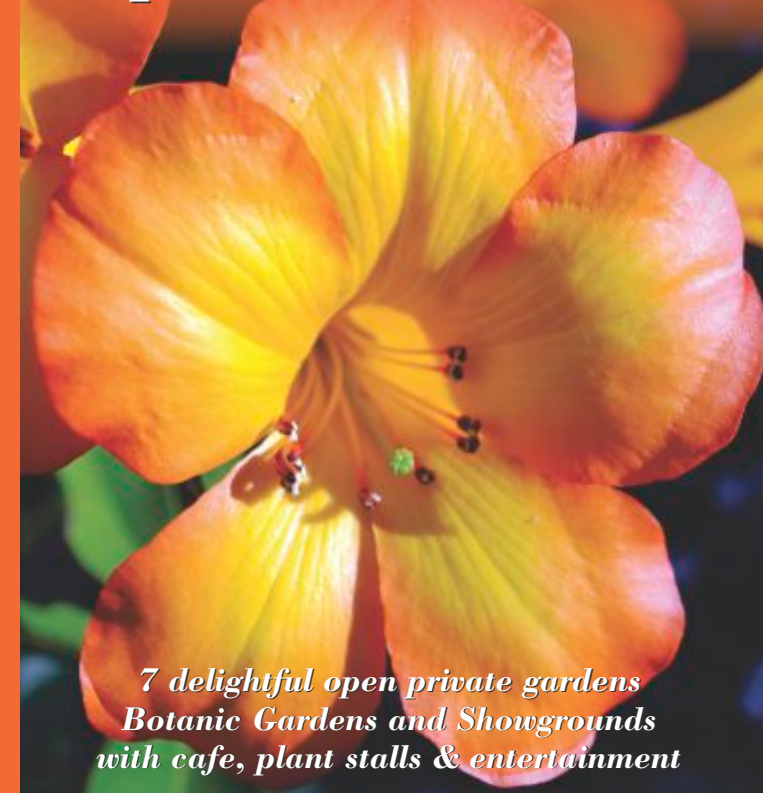

There are surprises and delights at every turn. A must-see garden of variety and colour. The recently-added fountain is a feature near the entry.

Allow 30+ minutes

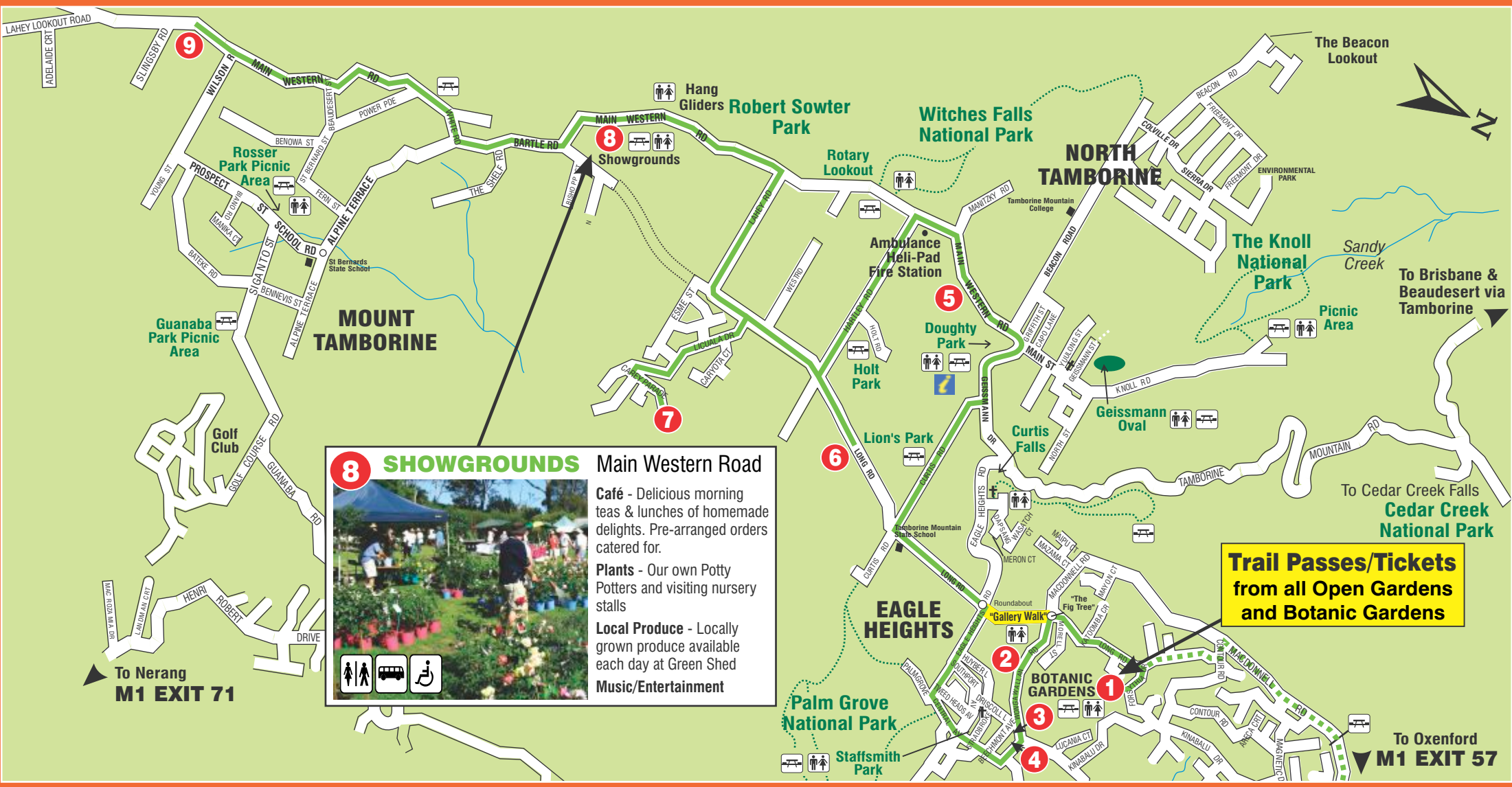


## 4 MONTVILLE Moreton Bay Avenue
