Bateke Road

Hidden away from view behind an informal gordonia hedge lies a tranquil, restful garden. This 7 year old 1 acre garden features camellias, azaleas, Japanese maples, conifers, vireyas, rhododendrons, bulbs and annuals as well as a productive vegetable garden. Cafe with morning and afternoon teas and a sausage sizzle.

Come in and see what you can do in one year. Symphony Hill is a lovely young garden on 2 acres which will fill you with delight. Deep curving rock borders are planted with a variety of cottage plants making a colourful display. At the back of the property is an amazing grove of mature chestnut trees.

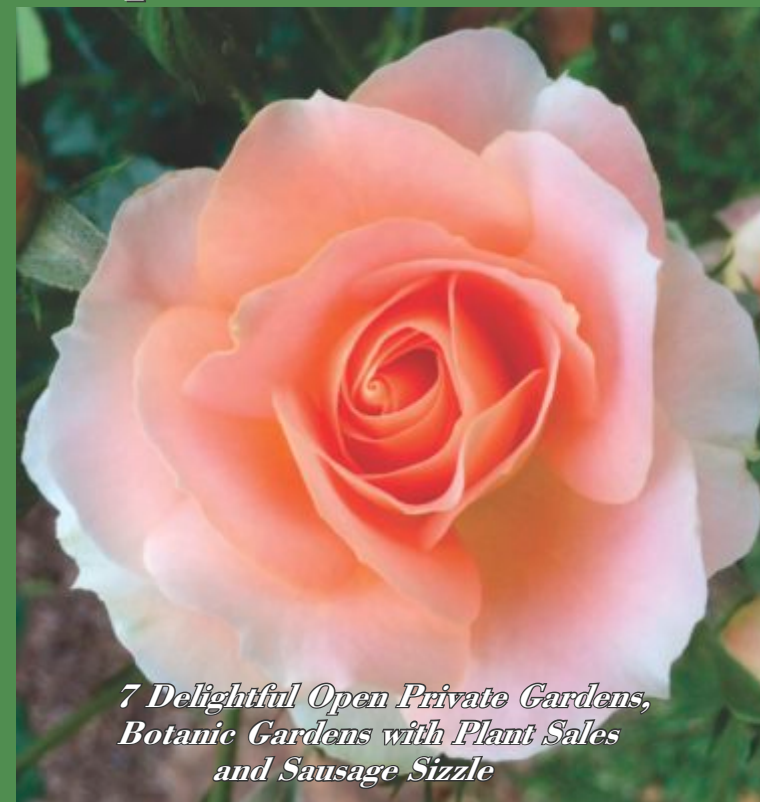

Allow 30+ minutes

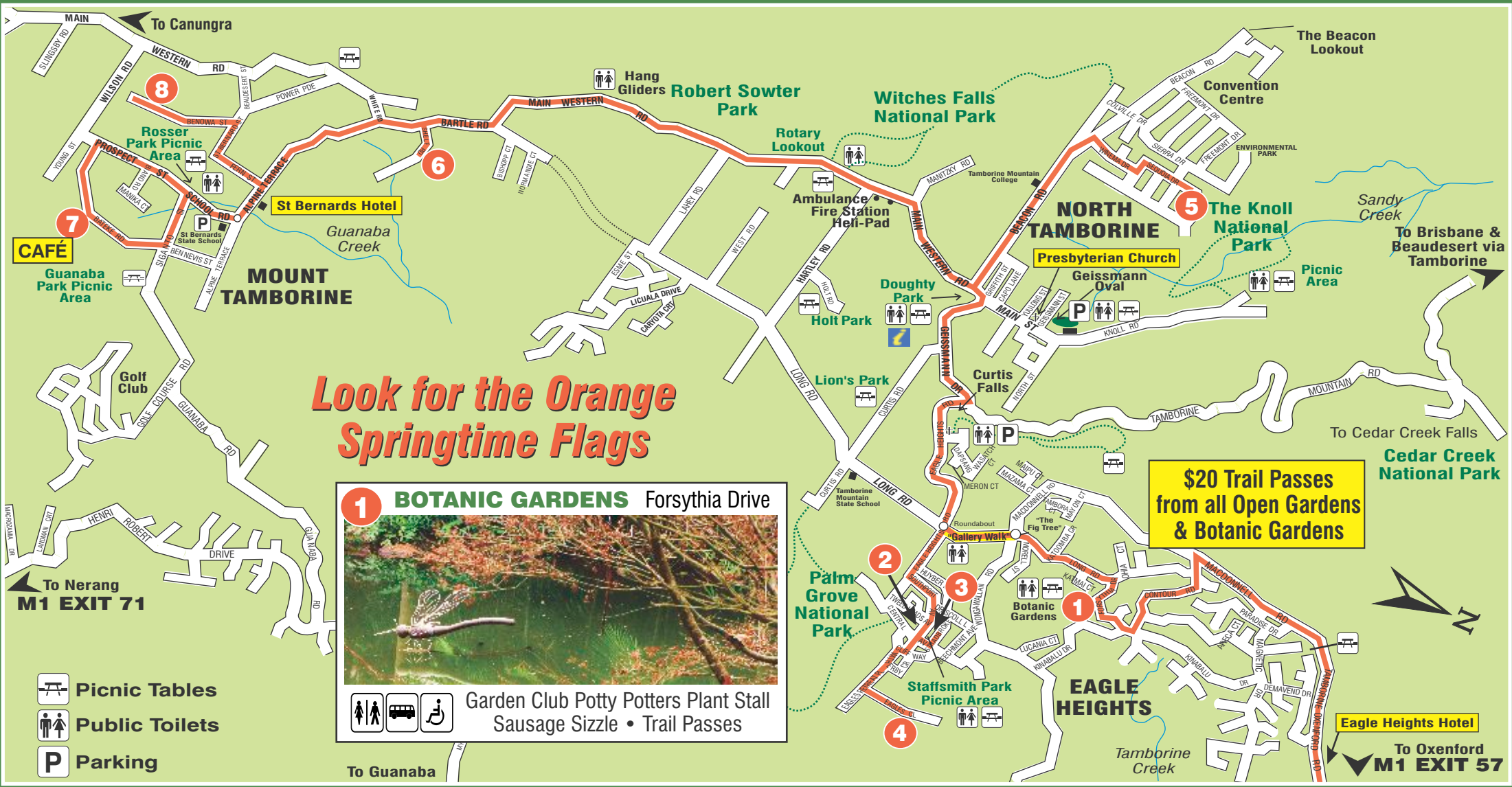


4 MONTECATINI Eagles Close
